Our new Mod3 outfitting system for our whitewater kayaks is setting a new standard for comfort, ease of adjustability, durability and hull support.



The spine of the integrated modular system creates a huge area of hull support to increase hull stiffness and prevent oilcanning. A cradle connects to the spine and deck, creating a very solid rib cage that increases the structural stability of the kayak.



The seat is super easy to adjust by simply unscrewing two thumbscrews. The seat can easily be taken out and replaced with a differently sized seat when needed, or to gain access to the stern of the kayak.



The Solos have an additional plastic pillar in the bow, providing some unique safety features. Apart from the obvious stiffening of the boat to prevent the cockpit from collapsing in case of a wrap, it also acts as a step out pillar in case of a vertical pin. A handle is shaped into the pillar for easier carrying of loaded boats. Two holes are moulded in through which rope, webbing or bungee cord can be threaded, allowing the user to attach a throw bag to the pillar.
